

"The 2021 Shadybrook Estate Cabernet Sauvignon captures Coombsville's cool climate with its deep ruby hue and rich, velvety texture. Aromas of graphite and fennel pollen mingle with notes of beef jerky, dark chocolate, and cedar. On the palate, silky and full-bodied flavors of black raspberry, espresso, and mocha are complemented by a rounded mouthfeel. Subtle oak integration adds a refined structure. The finish is long and elegant, leaving an impression after each sip. This vintage is perfect for Cabernet lovers, promising both aging potential and current enjoyment."
